



**JITKA TŮMOVÁ**, Secretary General and ADR Supervisor (incl. Domain Name Disputes) at the Czech Arbitration Court, CZ

Jitka studied Law at the Charles University in Prague and the University of Passau. After school Jitka worked over 4 years at the Czech Ministry of Finance, Financial Markets Department, where she participated i.a. in drafting EU regulation or at the pilot project on ADR for consumers with the Ministry of Industry and Trade and the Czech Arbitration Court (“CAC”).

Jitka left the Ministry to take part in the internet projects and apps for the modern education and intelligent housing and after finishing the main projects she accepted the invitation to become a Deputy Secretary General and ADR Supervisor at the Czech Arbitration Court. Over 2 years now she is coordinating both internal and external relations regarding the Court, supervising the proceedings and running the CAC Arbitration Centre for Internet Disputes.

Jitka is i.a. co-author of the recent “CAC .EU Overview 2.0” which contains crucial commentated decisions in .EU proceedings and member of the ECTA Internet Committee.
