Catherine Wolfe has an MA (Cantab) in Oriental Studies (Chinese) and a PhD in Anglo-Saxon Literacy, both from the University of Cambridge. She joined the profession as a trainee in January 1995 and qualified as a Registered Trade Mark Attorney in 1997. Since 2009 she has been a partner at Boulton Wade Tennant, working from the London office. Catherine has filed applications in virtually every country in the world which has a Trade Mark Register, and has represented numerous clients, from private individuals to major corporations, in ex parte and inter partes hearings at the UKIPO. She has acted for many clients before the EUIPO and its Boards of Appeal, and has worked on a number of cases which were appealed to the General Court. She is often asked to advise in commercially sensitive cases for very high profile companies and individuals. Catherine is also particularly interested in Chinese trade mark law and practice, and she has visited China on a number of occasions, often as part of an official delegation.
